The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

RES. 3826/77

THAT the following described lands were reserved for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public by Order-in-Council No. 2492, approved October 18, 1946.

Lot 10, Cowichan Lake District.
Containing 172 acres more or less.

AND THAT the said lands have been examined and found suitable and needed for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of the "Land Act", the said Order-in-Council No. 2492, be cancelled.

AND FURTHER TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of the "Department of Recreation and Conservation Act" the above described lands be constituted a Provincial park of Class "C" to be known as Lakeview Park. Subject, however, to the right of Mayo Holdings Limited its successors and assigns to the free and unrestricted use of a right-of-way granted for logging purposes under the provisions of the "Forest Act".


