Pursuant to the Park Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

The following described Crown lands, which have been examined and found suitable and needed for Recreation purposes, be designated as a Recreation Area to be known as Sunnybrae Provincial Recreation Area:

"Fractional Legal Subdivisions 1, 8, 10 and 15 and the Fractional South 1/2 of Legal Subdivision 9 of Section 10, Township 21, Range 10, West of the Sixth Meridian, Kamloops Division of Yale District, as shown on Plan of the Southeast 1/4 of said Township, dated at Ottawa, August 23, 1917, and containing 61.3 acres, more or less."
