The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT under authority of Section 94 of the "Land Act," being Chapter 175, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, the following described lands were reserved for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public pursuant to Order-in-Council No. 341, approved February 15th, 1957:

Lot B and that part of Lot C lying to the south of the road, all within the southeast quarter of Section 9, Township 23, Range 10, West of the Sixth Meridian and containing 4.93 acres more or less.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the authority of Section 96 of the "Land Act," being Chapter 175, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, the said reserve be cancelled.

AND FURTHER TO RECOMMEND THAT under the authority of the "Department of Recreation and Conservation Act," the above-described lands be constituted a Provincial Park of Class "C" to be known as Celista Park.
