THAT the following described lands have been reserved for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public.

That portion of Lot 1035 Kamloops Division of Yale District, lying to the South and West of the Eagle River and containing 24.4 acres more or less.

AND THAT the above described lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT, under authority of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, the above described lands be constituted a Provincial Park of Class "C" to be known as Sicamous Beach Park.
