The undersigned has the honour to report:

o/c 144/54
 THAT under the authority of Order-in-Council No. 1460, approved the 4th November 1938, the undermentioned area was reserved from pre-emption, sale, lease or license for a Provincial Park, being Lot 592, Group 2, New Westminster District, comprising 220 acres more or less.

 THAT under authority of Order-in-Council No. 156, approved 9th February 1940, the Park as originally established was extended by the addition of the following described area:

All that portion of the bed of Mud Bay which consists of the foreshore fronting on the north-westerly boundary of Lot 231, Group 2, New Westminster District, and which may be more particularly described as the strip of foreshore lying between the most easterly boundary of Lot 592, Group 2, New Westminster District, and the most northerly point of aforementioned Lot 231.

 TO FURTHER REPORT THAT under authority of Order-in-Council No. 1660, approved December 14th, 1940, the said Crescent Beach Park was reclassified as a Provincial Park Class "C".

AND TO FURTHER REPORT Crescent Beach Park contains 227 acres of water on foreshore within the boundaries of the Surrey Municipality and therefore considered of Municipal rather than Provincial import.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of Section 128 of the "Forest Act" being Chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, the said Crescent Beach Park be cancelled.

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT the said lands be reserved for the use, recreation, and enjoyment of the Public under the provisions of Section 94 of the "Land Act", being Chapter 175, R.S.B.C. 1948.
