The undersigned has the honour to report:


THAT pursuant to Orders-in-Council No. 1592 and 2680, approved June 19, 1962, and September 16, 1966, respectively, Elizabeth Lake Park, Class "C", Category 4 was established;

THAT the City of Cranbrook wishes to administer this park;

AND THAT within the said park there is land that is well suited for the recreational requirements of the residents of the said City;

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the authority of the Park Act, Elizabeth Lake Park be cancelled so that a Crown Grant of the land in question can be made to the City of Cranbrook for park purposes only.
