The undersigned has the honour to recommend:

THAT under authority of Section 96 of the "Land Act" being Chapter 175, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, the reserve covering the following described area established pursuant to Order-in-Council No. 1609, approved December 6th, 1940, be cancelled:

"North half of fractional north-west quarter and fractional legal subdivision 15 of Section 6; Legal Subdivision 2 and fractional south-west quarter of Section 7, Township 27, Range 21, West of the 5th Meridian, save and except the right-of-way of the Kootenay Central Railway".

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of Section 128 of the Forest Act, Chapter 128, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, and amendments, the following described lands be constituted a Provincial Park for the pleasure and recreation of the public to be known as "Golden Community Park":

"North half of the fractional north-west quarter and fractional legal subdivision 15 of Section 6; Legal Subdivision 2 and that part of the fractional west half of Section 7 lying south of Kicking Horse River, all in Township 27, Range 21, West of the 5th Meridian, save and except the right-of-way of the Kootenay Central Railway, containing an area of 368 acres."

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of Section 129 of the Forest Act, Chapter 128, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, and amendments, the said park be classified as a Provincial Park of Class "C".

MEMO

Provides for the cancellation of an existing recreational Reserve of certain lands at Golden and the establishment of a Class 'C' Park under the Forest Act covering such area together with land formerly held under lease by the Golden Provincial Park Board, comprising a total of 368 acres.
