To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to Report:

THAT under provisions of the Land Registry Act, Title to Block 12 of District Lots 337, Similkameen Division, Yale District, Plan 1280, containing 3.3 acres more or less, has been vested in the Crown Provincial for park purposes;

AND THAT the following described foreshore was reserved and set apart for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public;

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Lot 2883^S, being also the intersection of the West boundary of Cedar Street, as shown on Plan No. 1280, deposited in the Land Registry Office, Kamloops, with the high water mark of Skaha Lake; thence North 400 feet; thence East 718 feet more or less to a point due North of the Northwest corner of Lot 1, Block 13 of Lot 337, Plan 1280; thence South to the said Northwest corner, being a point on the high water mark of Skaha Lake; thence Westerly along the said high water mark to the point of commencement save and except thereout Lot 4087^S and containing 5 acres more or less.

AND THAT all of the above described lands and foreshore have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for Provincial Park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT all of the above described lands and foreshore be constituted a Provincial Park of Class "A", Category 5, to be known as "Christie Memorial Park".




