The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT certain lands situated at Beaver Harbour and comprising parts of Sections 21, 22, and 28, Township 6, Rupert Land District, were deleted from the Quatsino Forest by Order-in-Council No. 2013, approved on August 30th, 1958, in order that they might be reserved for public use.

THAT the said lands have high recreational values and are needed for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the authority of the "Department of Recreation and Conservation Act," being Chapter 53, Statutes of British Columbia, 1957, that those parts of the fractional southeast quarter of Section 28, the northeast quarter of Section 21, and the fractional northwest quarter of Section 22, all of Township 6, Rupert Land District, shown outlined in red on the attached print, be constituted a Provincial park of Class "C" to be known as Beaver Harbour Park, comprising 37 acres more or less.
