The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT a certain portion of land in the vicinity of Terrace was designated as park land on subdivision plan 3029, deposited in the Land Registry Office at Prince Rupert.

THAT there has been considerable local interest expressed in having this area administered under the Provincial Parks System.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the authority of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, that portion of land in Block 4, Lot 611, Range 5 Coast, designated as "park" and shown on plan 3029 deposited in the Land Registry Office at Prince Rupert, and containing 3.31 acres more or less, be constituted a Provincial Park of Class "C" to be known as Terrace Park.


