The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT pursuant to Order-in-Council No. 1917, approved July 27th, 1956, the following described lands have been acquired for and in the name of Her Majesty the Queen in right of the Province of British Columbia, for the establishment of a Provincial park, namely:

Sections 43 and 47, Metchosin District, containing 173.5 acres, more or less, except, out of Section 43, 5.69 acres thereof and except, out of Section 47, 2.67 acres thereof, comprising the right-of-way of the C.N.P.R. Company as shown coloured red on Plan 76 R.W.

and

That part of Section 76, Sooke District, lying easterly of a line drawn from the southeast corner of Section 124, Sooke District, to a point on the south boundary of said Section 76 distant 719.2 feet easterly from the northwest corner of Section 131, Sooke District, except, out of said part of Section 76, that part thereof included in the right-of-way of the C.N.P.R. Company as shown on Plan 76 R.W.

Together with

All rights and privileges granted in an easement appurtenant to Section 47, Metchosin District, except the right-of-way of the C.N.P.R. Company, over those parts of Sections 41 and 42, Metchosin District, shown outlined in red on Plan 683 R.W., and recorded in the Land Registry Office, Victoria, British Columbia, as 162820 G on C/T 214356 - I


AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of Section 128 of the "Forest Act" being Chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, the previously described lands be constituted a Provincial park to be known as "Matheson Lake Park" and that under the provisions of Section 129 of the "Forest Act" being Chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, said "Matheson Lake Park" shall be of Class "A".
