PARK ACT

Regulation made by Order-in-Council No. 1969, pursuant to Section 30. approved

Regulation Amending B.C. Reg. 70/67

The Provincial Parks Regulations, 1967, published as B.C. Regulation 70/67 and B.C. Regulation 121/69, are amended by deleting Section 10 (a) and substituting, therefore, the following:

- 10 (a) Except as may be authorized by a Park Use Permit or letter of authority, no person shall use or operate any power-boat or outboard motor in Murrin Park, Champion Lakes Park, or Alice Lake Park; or on Mike Lake in Garibaldi Park or Lightning Lake in Manning Park; or in Bowron Lake Park, except on Bowron Lake, of which Bowron Slough is not a part for the purpose of these regulations, Swan Lake and that portion of Spectacle Lake lying north of the most southerly corner of Lot 2053, Cariboo, at Pat's Point.
