The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report: *Res. 663/89*

THAT the following described lands have been reserved for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public.

Commencing at a point on the western boundary of Lot 205, Sayward Land District, said point being 7 chains North of the Southwest corner of said Lot 205; thence East 20 chains; thence North 20 chains; thence West 20 chains more or less to the Western boundary of Lot 205, Sayward Land District; thence South along the said western boundary 20 chains more or less to the point of commencement and containing 40 acres more or less.

AND THAT the above described lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under authority of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, the above described lands be constituted a Provincial Park of Class "C" to be known as Blenkin Memorial Park.
