The undersigned has the honour to report:

CANCELLED 593/83

THAT under the provisions of the "Land Registry Act", title to Casa Loma Park was vested in the Crown on deposit of Plan 1799, being a Plan of Subdivision of  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of Lot 505, and part of  $E\frac{1}{2}$  of Lot 505, Lot 506, Lot 507, Lot 2689, Lot 3461, Lot 2687, Lot 2688, Lot 1934 and Lot 3496, Group 1, O.D.Y.D.

AND THAT under the provisions of the said Act, title to Kalamoir Park was vested in the Crown on deposit of Plan 5381, being a Plan of Subdivision of District Lots 1118 and 2189; Parcels Y and Z, Lots 1 to 3 inclusive, Block 1, Plan 1799; and  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of District Lot 505, Lot 506, Lot 507, Lot 1934, Lot 2687, Lot 2688, Lot 2689, Lot 3461 and Lot 3496, O.D.Y.D.

AND THAT the Lakeview Irrigation District has requested that the above mentioned parks be designated a Provincial park of Class "C" to permit their management and improvement by a local park board.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of the "Department of Recreation and Conservation Act" the above mentioned parks be constituted a Provincial park of Class "C" to be known as Kalamoir Park.


