The undersigned has the honour to report;

o/c 343/64

THAT Block Nineteen (19) of District Lot Two Hundred and Twenty-one (221) Osoyoos Division, Yale District, Map One Hundred Seventy-seven (177) containing Two and Five Tenths (2.5) acres, more or less, was acquired by gift for park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of Section 128 of the "Forest Act" being Chapter 128, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, the previously described lands be constituted a Provincial park to be known as Antlers Beach Park and that under the provisions of Section 129 of the "Forest Act" being Chapter 128, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, said Antlers Beach Park shall be of Class "A".

AND FURTHER TO RECOMMEND THAT a certified copy of this minute, if approved, be forwarded to the Superintendent of Lands, Parliament Buildings, Victoria, B. C.
