The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT the following described Crown lands were reserved for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public:

Commencing at the southeast corner of Lot 4924 Lillooet Land District; thence south 35 chains; thence east 9 chains more or less to the east boundary of the right-of-way of Highway 97; thence northerly along said east boundary to its intersection with the south boundary of Lot 4924; thence easterly along said south boundary 7 chains more or less to the point of commencement and containing approximately 31 acres.

AND THAT the above described lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes;

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under authority of the Park Act the above described lands be constituted a Provincial Park of Class "C" Category 4, to be known as Kersey Lake Park.
