THAT pursuant to Order-in-Council No. 109, approved January 16, 1962, the following described lands were created a park of Class "C", known as Clinton Creek Park.


Lots 80A, 80B, 81B, 92, 92A, 93, 93A, 94 and 94A, all of Lillooet District, Townsite of Clinton and containing 1.5 acres more or less.

THAT the Corporation of the Village of Clinton wishes to acquire the above described lands for a village park.


THAT the above described lands are no longer required for Provincial park purposes.

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the authority of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, Clinton Creek Park be cancelled.
