The Lieutenant-Governor in Council: 1774/83

The undersigned has the honour to Report:

THAT the following described lands have been donated to the Crown Provincial for park purposes:

Legal Subdivisions 2 and 7, East Halves of Legal Subdivisions 3, 6, and 11 and South Half of Legal Subdivision 10 of Section 29, Township 4, Range 29, West of the Sixth Meridian, New Westminster District, except Part on Plan 23198, and containing 155 acres more or less;

AND THAT the following described lands have been reserved for the use, recreation and enjoyment of the public:

Legal Subdivisions 4 and 5, the West Half of Legal Subdivisions 3, 6 and 11, the South Half of Legal Subdivision 12, Section 29, and the West Half of Legal Subdivision 13, Section 20, all of Township 4, Range 29, West of the Sixth Meridian, and containing 180 acres more or less;

AND THAT all the above described lands are subject to the prior rights of conditional Water Licence No. 28288;

AND THAT the above described lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes;

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under authority of the Department of Recreation and Conservation Act, the above described lands be constituted a Provincial park of Class "A" to be known as Weaver Creek Park.
