To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT pursuant to Orders-in-Council No. 2992, approved December 30, 1959; No. 682, approved March 4, 1966; and No. 501, approved February 16, 1968, Harwood Point Park Class "C", was established over the following described lands and foreshore:

1. The fractional Section 16, Texada Island District, and containing 40 acres, more or less.
2. Commencing at a point on the high-water-mark of Texada Island on the westerly shore thereof, said point being the northwest corner of fractional Section 16, Texada Island; thence West to a point perpendicularly distant 500 feet westerly from the said high-water-mark; thence in a general southerly direction parallel to and perpendicularly distant 500 feet westerly from the high-water-mark of Section 16, Texada Island, a distance of 1250 feet more or less to a point bearing North 63° West from the most westerly point on the high-water-mark of the said Section 16; thence South 63° E to the said most westerly point; thence in a general northerly direction along the high-water-mark of Section 16 to the point of commencement and containing 20 acres more or less.
3. Commencing at a point on the high-water-mark of Texada Island, said point being the southeast corner of fractional Section 16, Texada Island; thence South 46° West more or less for a distance of 500 feet; thence westerly perpendicularly distant 500 feet from and parallel to the high-water-mark of Section 16, Texada Island a distance of 1215 feet more or less to a point bearing South 10° East from the most westerly point on the high-water-mark of the said Section 16; thence North 10° West to the said most westerly point; thence easterly along the high-water-mark to the point of commencement and containing approximately 17 acres.

AND THAT the Powell River Regional District has requested that the above described park lands be transferred to the administration of said Regional District;


AND THAT these lands have been examined and found to be of greater regional rather than provincial recreational significance;

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under provisions of the Park Act, Harwood Point Park Class "C" be cancelled.
