THAT the following described Crown Land has been donated to the Crown Provincial for park purposes by Her Royal Highness the Princess Margaret:

Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 (Portland Island) Cowichan District and containing approximately 480 acres.

AND THAT all of the above lands have been examined and found to be suitable and needed for park purposes;

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under authority of the "Park Act" all of the above described lands be established a Class "A" Park of Category 6 to be known as Princess Margaret Marine Park.
