To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT pursuant to Order-in-Council No. 2768 approved August 29, 1968, Myrtle Rocks Park Class "C", was established over the following described land:

Parcel "F" (Explanatory Plan 3106) of District Lot 1499,
Group 1, New Westminster District

and

Commencing at a point on the high-water-mark of Malaspina Strait, said point being the northeast corner of Lot 6977, Group 1, New Westminster District; thence southerly along the easterly boundary of said Lot 6977 and a southerly prolongation thereof a total distance of 680 feet; thence South 76°30' West, 650 feet; thence due West 1120 feet; thence due South 870 feet; thence due East 1850 feet; thence North 40°0' East 950 feet more or less, to the most westerly southwest corner of Lot 7171 Group 1 New Westminster District; thence North 40°0' East along the northwesterly boundary of said Lot 7171 and a northeasterly prolongation thereof a total distance of 400 feet more or less to the high-water-mark of Malaspina Strait; thence in a northwesterly direction along the said high-water-mark to the point of commencement and containing approximately 53.4 acres.

AND THAT pursuant to Order-in-Council No. 4183 approved November 22, 1971, Myrtle Rocks Park was extended by the addition of the following described area:


Commencing at a point on the high-water-mark of Malaspina Strait, said point being 88.8 feet North 40°00 East of the northeast corner of Lot 7171 Group 1, New Westminster District; thence South 40°00 W, 1350 feet more or less, to the southeast corner of Myrtle Rocks Park; thence North 62½° East 1460 feet more or less to the high-water-mark of Malaspina Strait; thence in a northwesterly direction along said high-water-mark to the point of commencement and containing approximately 7.7 acres.

AND THAT the Powell River Regional District has requested that the above described park lands be transferred to the administration of said Regional District;


AND THAT these lands have been examined and found to be of greater regional rather than provincial recreational significance;

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under provisions of the Park Act, Myrtle Rocks Park Class "C" be cancelled.
