To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT pursuant to Order-in-Council No. 1503, approved June 7, 1962, Haslam Lake Park Class "C" was established over the following described lands:

Commencing at the northeast corner of Lot 5698, New Westminster District, being on the edge-of-the-bed of Haslam Lake; thence West along the North boundary of Lot 5698 to the northwest corner thereof; thence West 10 chains; thence North 3 chains; thence West 8 chains; thence North 5 chains more or less to the edge-of-the-bed of Haslam Lake; thence easterly and southerly along the said edge-of-the-bed to the point of commencement and containing approximately 40 acres, subject however, to Conditional Water Licence No. 24036.

AND THAT the Powell River Regional District has requested that the above described park lands be transferred to the administration of said Regional District;


AND THAT these lands have been found to be of greater regional rather than provincial recreational significance;

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the provisions of the Park Act, Haslam Lake Park Class "C", be cancelled.
