The undersigned has the honour to report:

THAT the following described vacant Crown lands have been examined and are considered to have a high recreational value:

That portion of the fractional northwest quarter of Section 10, Township 20, Range 18, W6M, lying north of the left bank of the Thompson River, and that portion of the fractional southwest quarter of Section 15, Township 20, Range 18, W6M, lying south of the right bank of the Thompson River, save and except the area within the right-of-way for the Trans-Mountain Oil Pipeline, shown on Plan A1293, deposited in the Kamloops Land Registry Office, and containing approximately 15 acres.

AND THAT the above described lands are needed for park purposes;

AND TO RECOMMEND THAT under the authority of the Park Act the above described lands be created a Provincial park of Class "C", Category 4, to be known as Mission Flats Park.
