ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS April 17, 2020, is the 100th anniversary both of the first provincial legislation governing these professions and of the creation of the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of the Province of British Columbia (known as Engineers and Geoscientists BC), and

WHEREAS Engineers and Geoscientists BC has been at the forefront of shaping safety, innovation and growth in these professions in the province of British Columbia over the last 100 years, and

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 17, 2020, shall be known as


“Engineers and Geoscientists BC 100th Anniversary Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.


