

## SCHEDULE

*1 Section 48 of the Liquor Control and Licensing Regulation, B.C. Reg. 244/2002, is repealed and the following substituted:*

### **Room service**

- 48** (1) This section applies to a licensed establishment that
- (a) is the subject of a food primary licence, a liquor primary licence, a liquor primary club licence, a brewery lounge endorsement, a distillery lounge endorsement or a winery lounge endorsement, and
  - (b) is located in the same building as a business offering overnight accommodation to registered guests.
- (2) Subject to limitation by the general manager, a licensed establishment described in subsection (1) may do the following:
- (a) despite sections 9 (1) (b), 11 (2) (c) and 18 (3), sell and serve liquor to registered guests in their rooms during any period that room service meals are available to those guests;
  - (b) supply or operate a minibar service through which liquor may be purchased at any time in guest rooms.
