SCHEDULE

- 1** *Section 1 (1) of the Liquor Control and Licensing Regulation, B.C. Reg. 244/2002, is amended in the definition of “private special occasion” by adding the following paragraph:*
- (d) a competitive event for the evaluation or judging of wine, beer or cider if
 - (i) the licensee is an individual who is a member of and a representative for a genuine organization,
 - (ii) the event is organized and hosted by the organization,
 - (iii) attendance is limited to the organization’s members or staff, to invited guests or to persons to whom tickets have been provided, without charge, before the event, and
 - (iv) awards or another form of recognition are granted to the makers of the wine, beer or cider based on the evaluation or judging; .
- 2** *Section 15 (13) is amended by striking out “paragraph (c)” and substituting “paragraph (c) or (d)”.*
