ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,  
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the  
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

**To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting**

WHEREAS British Columbia's motion picture, music, book and magazine publishing, and interactive and digital media industries (the Creative Industries) employ thousands of skilled British Columbian professionals to produce a wide range of products and services, many of them interconnected and all highly innovative, employing cutting-edge technology, and

WHEREAS British Columbia's Creative Industries significantly contribute to the economic, social, artistic and cultural identity of British Columbia, and

WHEREAS British Columbia's Creative Industries significantly contribute to British Columbia's profile on the world stage, driving growth in entertainment, technology, education, tourism and hospitality sectors, and

WHEREAS the Government of British Columbia recognizes the partnership between business, government, Indigenous partners and the community, working together to build a sustainable and competitive creative economy that will employ new generations of British Columbians well into the future;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 29 to May 6, 2019 shall be known as
